Save-A-Lot Dealer Program Withdrawn

StoreNext regrets to announce that the Save-A-Lot Dealer program must be withdrawn as of September 1, 2004. Despite the best efforts of some Dealers and StoreNext's commitment to all-Dealer distribution, together we have not maintained the consistent standard of operations and service called for by a chain of SAL's size and scope. Because of these issues the customer now requires all future ISS45 products and services be purchased from their local Dealer only.

All Save-A-Lot Dealer orders currently in the StoreNext pipeline will naturally be honored under the terms of the Save-A-Lot program. As of September 1, 2004 no further Save-A-Lot system orders will be accepted other than from SAL's designated local Dealer. The program outlined in Marketing Bulletin 1190 is formally withdrawn.
