Connected Payments Offering and Pricing Changes

March 7, 2008

The Connected Payments BIN file service has been added to the small-store and standard Criterion packages. This enables subscribers of all Connected Payments packages to implement credit→debit conversion. StoreNext has also made two pricing changes – these will apply to all new Connected Payments subscriptions as of April 1, 2008.

- The pre-licensed Criterion offer has been withdrawn. This offered a \$15/week price for a two-year period to subscribers who had already purchased WinEPS and POS payments options prior to October 1, 2007. Pre-licensed customers can still take advantage of the pre-licensed Summit offer, which provides Summit for a 30% discount.
- The weekly subscription for the small-store Criterion package has been repriced to \$30 from the previous \$25. The small-store Summit package remains at \$40.



A \$150 per store setup service charge will apply to all Connected Payments subscription agreements as of April 1.

The special FSA upgrade offer, in effect since October 1, will expire March 31. Any prospects considering Connected Payments proposals should be advised that their agreements must be complete and in StoreNext's hands by the end of this month to receive the benefits of the FSA Upgrade offer or the original pricing. FSA Upgrade customers must be installed and processing by the end of April for the offer to apply.
