





Introduction

Enhancements were recently made to the StoreNext ISS45 system. The changes are reflected in the accompanying ISS45 7.1.5.0-110 software. The Change Request Document (CRD) number assigned to each enhancement is listed in the description heading.

Following the change description is an abbreviation (or combination thereof) of the ISS45 area affected:

(BO) – Back Office

(POS) – WinPOS

(Sys) – System / Services

These enhancements are explained in detail in the following pages and are not included in the latest Office Users Guide, WinPOS User Guide and Office Administrator's Reference. If you have any questions regarding this release, please contact StoreNext Support.

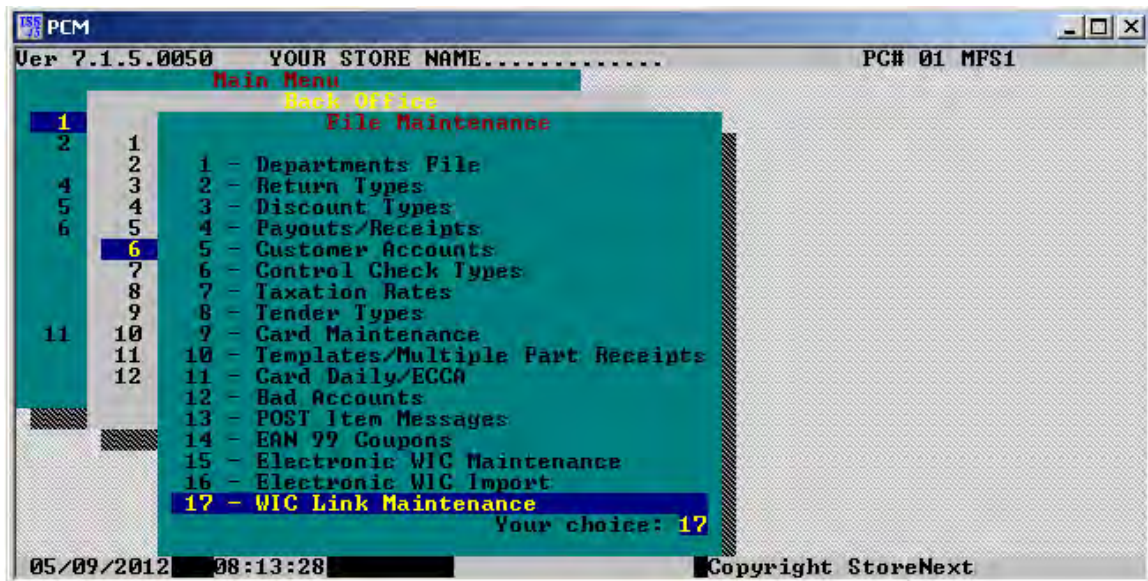
281469 – Integrated WIC Link Maintenance (BO)

WIC Link Maintenance is now integrated into the ISS45 Back Office menu and the application has the same “look and feel” as other File Maintenance applications.

Note:

WIC Link Maintenance is used to map the store's PLU/UPC number to the PLU/UPC number in the state APL file for those items (fresh fruit and vegetables) that do not match. In previous releases, the program was a standalone application.

WIC Link Maintenance (1-6-17) now appears under the File Maintenance Menu:



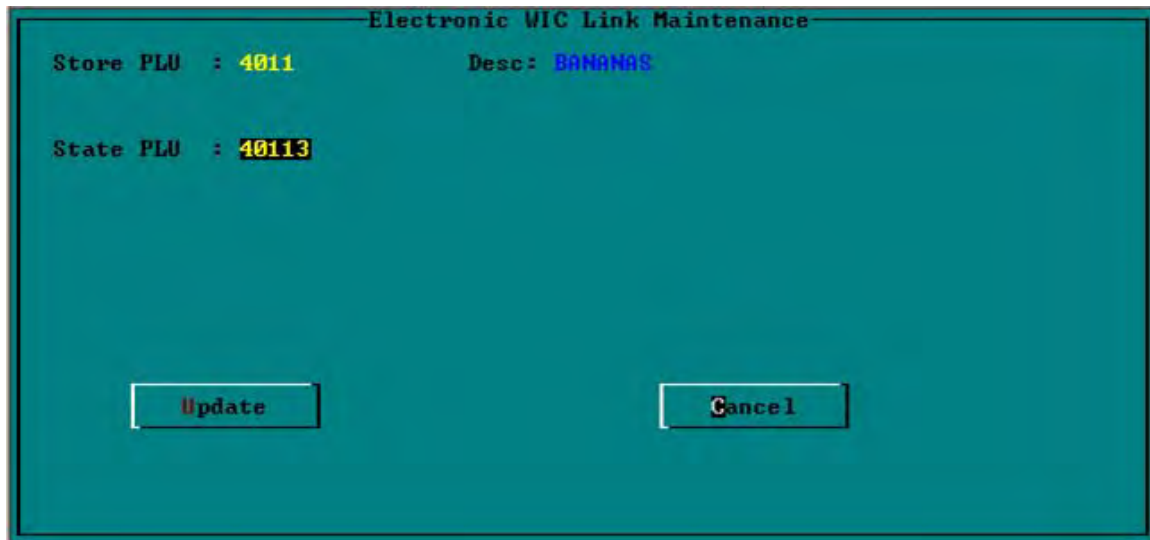
Once selected, the WIC Link Maintenance screen appears, displaying all previous mapped PLU items. The list is sorted by PLU Number and displays the following columns:

- Store PLU/UPC Number
- Item Description
- Postal Code
- State APL PLU/UPC Number



➤ To map a store PLU to the state APL file:

1 Click the **Insert Link** button. The WIC Link screen displays:



2 Key in the store PLU\UPC code for the item. The description of the store item displays.

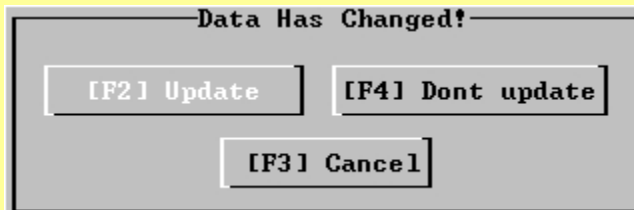
3 Key in the state PLU\UPC code for the item.

4 Click **Update** to add the new link. The link will be added for all configured states whose imported APL contains the entered State PLU.

5 When finished inserting links, click the **Update and exit** button from Electronic WIC Link Maintenance screen.

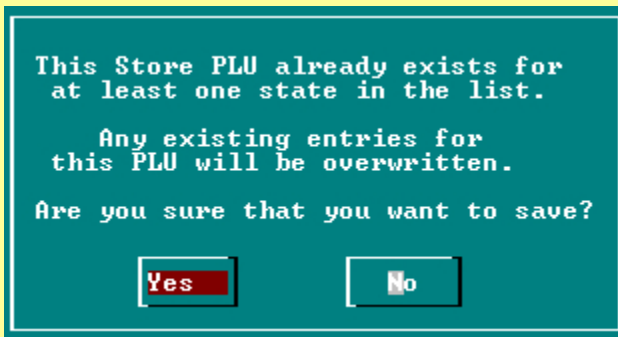
Note:

If **Cancel** is pressed when inserting, modifying or deleting an link (or when the **Abort Maint** button is pressed from the Electronic WIC Maintenance screen after maintenance has been performed), the following confirmation message displays:



Press **F2** to save the maintenance, **F4** to abort the maintenance or **F3** to cancel the function and return to Electronic WIC Maintenance.

If the state PLU already exists in the list for any state, the following warning message will display (requesting to overwrite all state entries for this PLU):



Choose **Yes** to overwrite all previous links for the item or **No** to abort the update. (To change linkage on a state by state basis, use the **Modify Link** function).

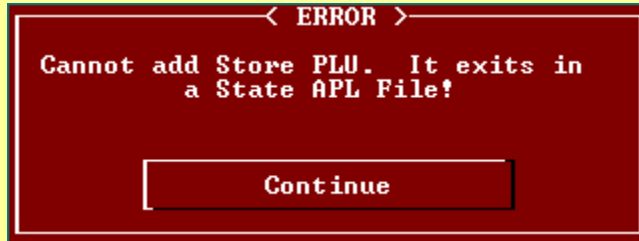
If the entered store PLU does not exist in the item file, the following warning message displays:



If the entered store PLU exists in item file but the entered state PLU does not exist in an imported APL file, the following warning message displays:



If the entered store PLU exists in an imported APL file, mapping is prohibited and the following warning message displays:



➤ **To modify a store-to-state APL file mapping:**

- 1 Locate and highlight the Store-to-State PLU row in the WIC Link listing. Click the **Modify Link** button. The Electronic WIC Link Maintenance form displays:



- 2 Enter the correct State PLU number for the item.
- 3 Click **Update** to save the modified link.
- 4 When finished modifying links, click the **Update and exit** button from Electronic WIC Link Maintenance screen

➤ **To delete a store-to-state APL file link:**

- 1 Locate and highlight the Store-to-State PLU row in the WIC Link listing for the link to delete. Click the **Delete Link** button. The link is removed from the list.
- 2 When finished deleting links, click the **Update and exit** button from Electronic WIC Link Maintenance screen

312604 – Databar Coupon Description Enhancements (BO/POS)

Parameters found in this release provide the retailer with new options for how Databar Coupons appear on the customer receipt. In previous releases, if the Databar Parameter “Use Databar coupon attached item description” was checked (6-1-5-7, #5), the Databar Coupon line appeared on the receipt with the same description as the item receiving the coupon discount (making it difficult for the customer to identify the coupon):

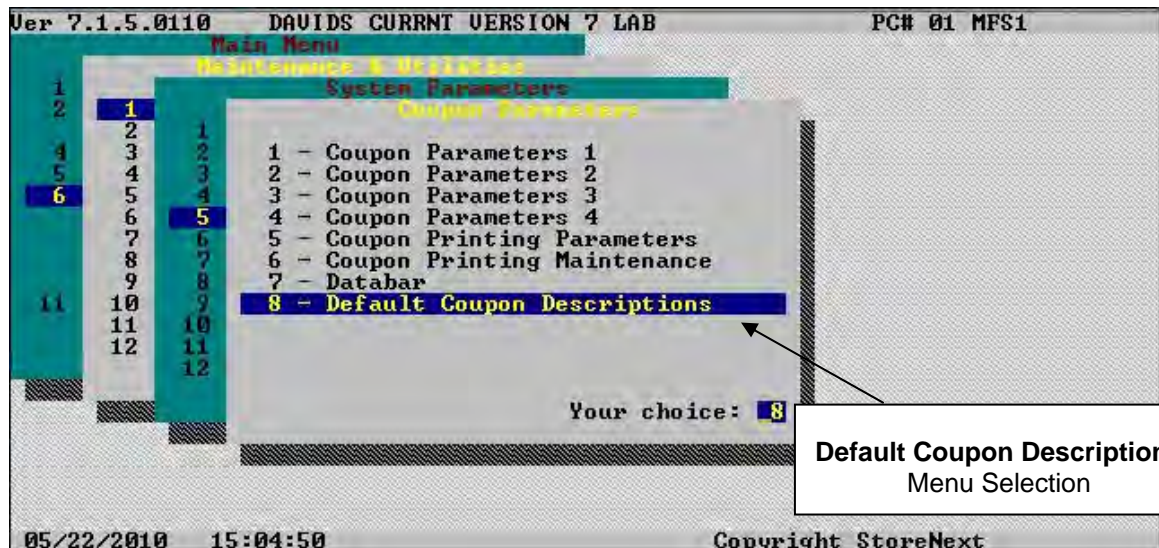

Depending on how the parameters are set, Databar Coupon descriptions printed on the receipt may now either be the same for each type of coupon (Store or Vendor) or may continue to contain a partial description of the linked coupon (but with a prefix of “CPN”).

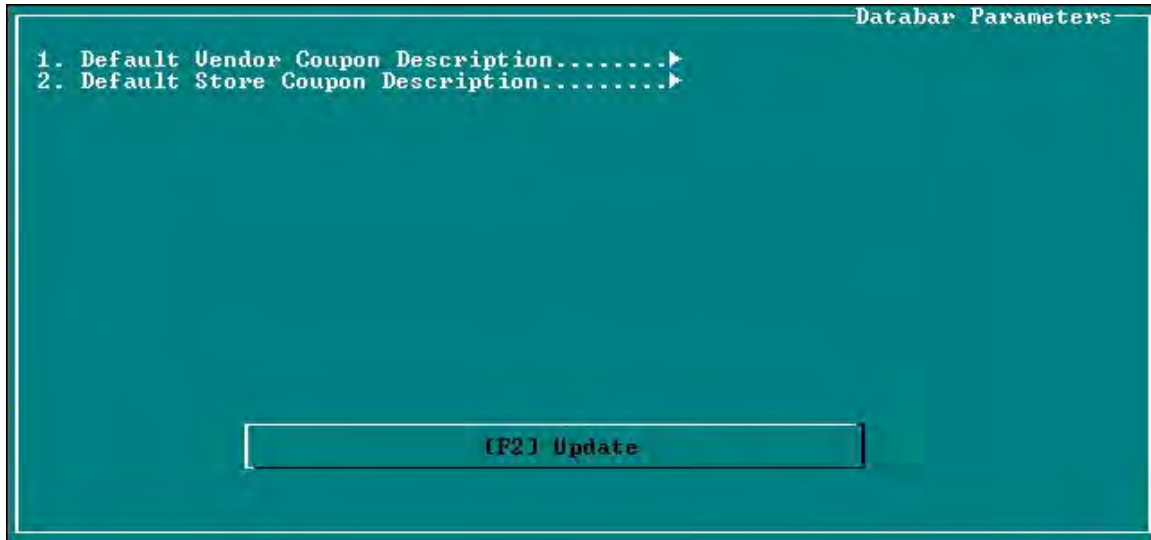

New Menu Selection

Coupon Descriptions are maintained under the **new** Default Coupon Descriptions menu selection (6-1-5-8). The new Databar Parameters Screen displays when selected.



Databar Parameters Screen



Parameter	Explanation
Default Vendor Coupon Description	<p>This parameter specifies the description that will print on the customer receipt for a Vendor Databar Coupon. The default is blank.</p> <p>Note: This parameter is only used if the Databar Parameter "Use Databar coupon attached item description" (6-1-5-7, #5) is unchecked.</p> <p>Note: If the Store Coupon flag within the Databar coupon structure is set to 0, then the coupon is considered to be a Vendor Coupon.</p>
Default Store Coupon Description	<p>This parameter specifies the description that will print on the customer receipt for a Store Databar Coupon. The default is blank.</p> <p>Note: This parameter is only used if the Databar Parameter "Use Databar coupon attached item description" (6-1-5-7, #5) is unchecked.</p> <p>Note: If the Store Coupon flag within the Databar coupon structure is set to 1, then the coupon is considered to be a Store Coupon.</p>

POS

When the “Use Databar coupon attached item description” parameter (6-1-5-7, #5) is checked, the Databar coupon line now prints the prefix “CPN” before the truncated item description:

V8 FUSION CAMPBELL	\$1.19	F
CPN V8 FUSION CAMP	-\$1.00	F

If the “Use Databar coupon attached item description” (6-1-5-7, #5) parameter is unchecked, the POS uses the Default Coupon Descriptions parameters for all Databar Coupons.

Note:

If the “Use Databar coupon attached item description” (6-1-5-7, #5) parameter is unchecked and the Default Coupon Description parameters are left blank, “Description” will print on the receipt for Databar Coupons.

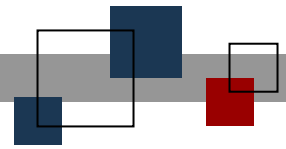
