Introduction

Enhancements were recently made to the StoreNext ISS45 system. The changes are reflected in the accompanying ISS45 8.1.5.2-060 software. The Change Request Document (CRD) number assigned to each enhancement is listed in the description heading.

The Change Request Document (CRD) number assigned to each enhancement is listed in the description heading. Following the change description is an abbreviation (or combination thereof) of the ISS45 area affected:

(FO) – Front Office

(POS) – WinPOS

(Sys) – System / Services

These enhancements are explained in detail in the following pages and are not included in the latest Office Users Guide, WinPOS User Guide or Office Administrator's Reference. If you have any questions regarding this release, please contact StoreNext Support.

242450 – Auto Enable for APL Item Import (FO)

The **Enable WIC Sale** flag is now automatically checked in Electronic WIC Items Maintenance when an item is first imported from the state APL file. The status of this flag is also now retained (enabled or disabled) when the item subsequently re-imported from updated APL files.

Note:

In previous releases, the **Enable WIC Sale** flag was disabled for all items after each APL import. Retailers were required to re-enable each item that was active in the Electronic WIC program after each APL import.

Note:

When a retailer implements a Least Expensive Brand (LEB) item, the store must disable the **Enable WIC Sale** flag in Electronic WIC Items Maintenance for all competing brands.

236178 – Auto Enable for WIC Linked Items (FO)

The **Enable WIC Sale** flag is now automatically checked in Electronic WIC Items Maintenance for store items that are linked to state items (through WIC Link Maintenance) during APL file import.

Note:

Since the state's PLU codes for fruit and vegetable items included in the state APL file may not match the store's item file, the WIC Link Maintenance program populates the WIC item file on the POS with these items. The linkage does not take effect until the next EOD or until the Electronic WIC Import is run for the state's APL file.

Other Enhancements

236190 – Similar to a non-void function when the **0** key is pressed before the **Qty** key, the following message displays when this key sequence is used after the Void (Subtract Item) function is selected:

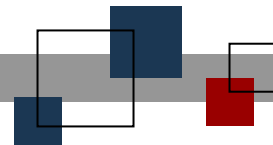
