Introduction

Enhancements were recently made to the ISS45 system. The changes are reflected in the accompanying ISS45 8.1.8.1-150 software.

Following the change description is an abbreviation (or combination thereof) of the ISS45 area affected:

- POS – WinPOS
- SSCO – Self-Service Check-Out

These enhancements are explained in detail in the following pages, and are not included in the latest Office Users Guide, WinPOS User Guide or Office Administrator's Reference. If you have any questions regarding this release, please contact NCR Support.

ISS45-1302 – SSCO: Need to Support Mixed Basket EBT FS Transactions Using the Generic EFT Key

The connected payments get the whole total amount, when using the Generic EFT key, even on the PIN Pad the EBT FS tender is selected. If the FoodStampable total is not the whole total amount, the SSCO will display over tender not allowed.

The Generic EFT need to be sent to the PIN PAD by the SSCO. The whole tender amount and the FS tender amount need to be held by ISS45. Once the tender is selected on the PIN Pad, the correct total needs to come from ISS45 to send out for approval.

ISS45-1394 - Sprout's Support for Loyalty Pro Promotions as Tender for their Mobile Coupon Type Promotions

An improvement was made to the “Mean of Payment” enhancement that was done for ISS45 with Loyalty.

The General System Parameter “Convert Mean of Payment Promotion to Tender” = YES, allows customers to change a “Mean of Payment” promotion to a tender. On the Store Sales Report, the “Mean of Payment” Promotions were still reporting as “Promotion Discounts”. When in fact, it needs to report to the “Tender”. Mean of Payment tenders are “Vendor” and “Store” Coupons, and are now reporting the “Tender Type” as Vendor/Store Coupons in the Store Sales Report.

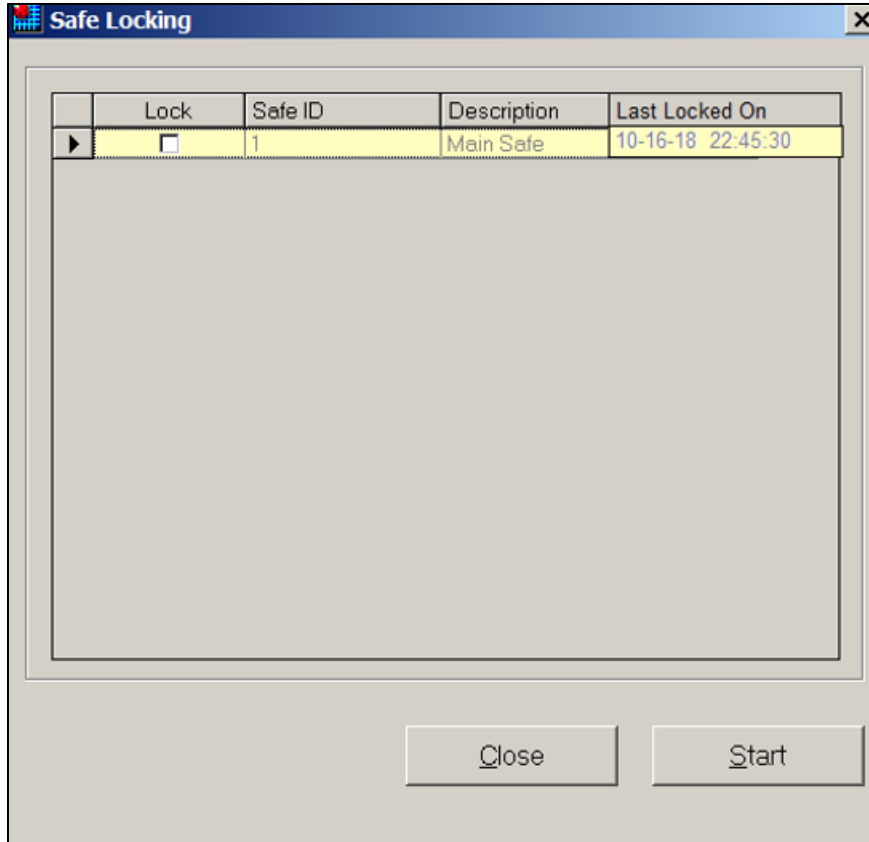
ISS45-1396 - Prevent Multiple Safe Lock during a Business Day

"Prevent Multiple Locks per Business Date" is a new GSP that has been created. It is available in General System Parameters under the Safe Parameters\Safe Locking Parameters. By default, it is set to "No".

GSP Description: This parameter provides the option to prevent multiple Safe Locks per business day for each Safe defined.

On the Screen of Safe Locking, here is what it should be:

- To display the Last Date/Time the Safe was locked, an additional column is to be added. The column header should be Last Locked On.



- If this is the first time, the Safe is locked during this business date, then the last Locked On should be updated.
- Lastly, if the created GSP (Prevent Multiple Locks per Business Date) is true, then for this business date, safes have already been locked. The safe should be prevented from being locked again, and a message should appear. Here is an example: A system have 5 safes, if safes 1-3 have been locked already, then the following message should display.

- Safe # 1 has already been locked since last EOD.
- Safe # 2 has already been locked since last EOD.
- Safe # 3 has already been locked since last EOD.

The Safes 4 and/or 5 can be lock by user, last Locked On column should be updated, and all the previously locked safes should be unchecked by the application.

- If the created GSP "Prevent Multiple Locks per Business Date" is False, the flag of Prevent_lock does not need to be set, and the safes can be locked multiple time during the business day.

In the dbo.SAFE_DEF table, here is what it should be:

- The table needs an additional column: Prevent_Lock (bit, null).
- If the created GSP "Prevent Multiple Locks per Business Date" is TRUE, then the Locked Safe value will be set to 1.

Here is what the values mean, 0 means Safe is Unlocked and 1 means Safe is Locked.

What does the End Of Day (EOD) do?

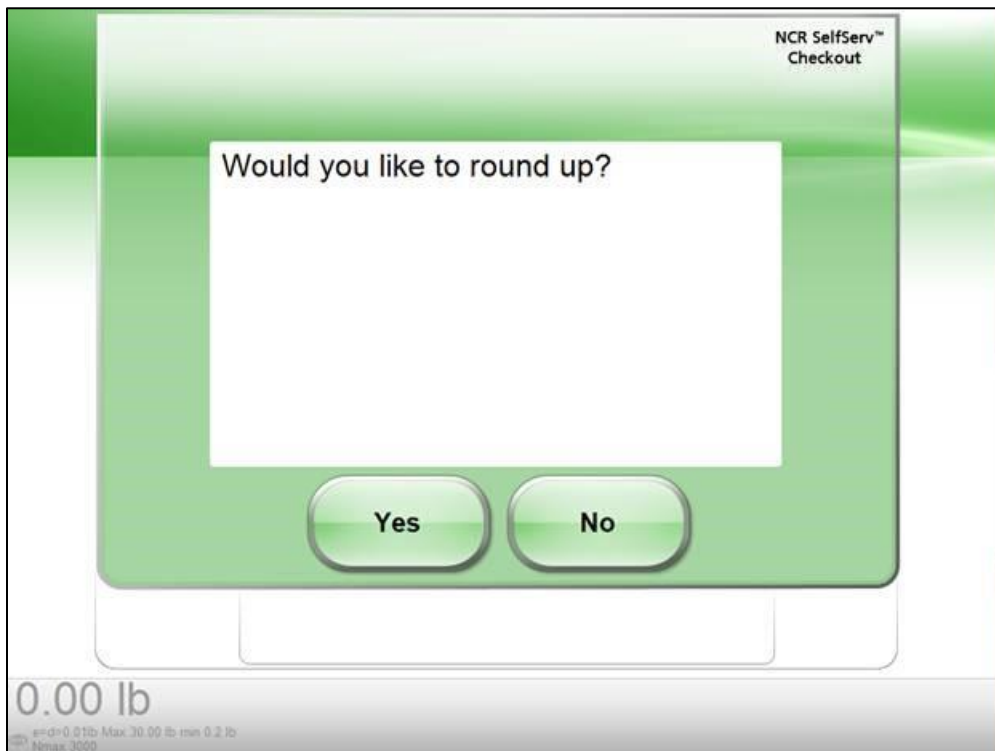
The Locked Safes will be reset to unlocked safe status by the EOD, and the Prevent_Lock field in the dbo.SAFE_DEF table will update to 0.

ISS45-1423 – Fully Support Round-Up Feature on NCR SSCO

The round-up feature can now be used on the SSCO. The GSP “Enabled prompt for round-up of ticket total” can be enabled and functions with the SSCO. The round-up Prompt will not prompt the customer on the PIN Pad as the regular lanes will, but on the SSCO screen. This screen will display once the Finish and Pay button is pressed and before the Tender selections display.

The message configured in the GSP’s will be the message displayed to the customer.

Note: This feature also requires the Transaction Broker to be upgraded to 5.00.01.00.68.



ISS45-1432 – PA WIC needs an SFTP Template Support

The SFTP template support is needed by PA WIC. The PA FTP structure needs to be supported by Version 2 of the SWFTP.dat. Only the 'In' and the 'Out' folder is supported by PA.

For the version 2, the changes that were made to SWFTP4.dat, were also be made to SWFTP.dat.
