# Introduction

Several new features and enhancements were made recently to the ScanMaster system as a result of customer change requests. These changes are reflected in the accompanying 1.03.01-050 software.

These improvements are explained in detail in the following pages and are not included in your ScanMaster User Guide or Installation & Support Guide. Please keep this system update with your User Guides for quick reference. If you have any questions regarding this release, please contact StoreNext Support.

## ScanMaster HASP Security

ScanMaster security in 1.03.01 is now handled through a hardware key called a "HASP". The HASP needs to be either connected to the ScanMaster Server's parallel port or USB port (depending on the HASP model). The HASP must be installed for ScanMaster software to run. **No temporary grace periods for operation are granted. Do not perform the upgrade to 1.03.01 until a properly programmed HASP is available.**

To check the HASP security settings at a store, the program <DefDrive>:\Grocery\SMSSDSP.EXE can be run on the server. It will display the screen below, showing the ScanMaster software that is authorized for the HASP currently installed on the system.

## Pricer Electronic Shelf Labels (ESL)

This release of ScanMaster contains a new interface to Pricer ESL (Electronic Shelf Labels). A new “Pricer Server” service (similar to the Electronic Journal) monitors Pricer ESL activity. A warning message will display if inactivity time exceeds the minutes specified in the “Warn After # Min Pricer Service Inactivity” Back Office Control File Setting (see below).

Changed item record information (whether performed through ScanMaster or RPO) is written to the Pricer Btrieve Buffer File (GR2ESL.BTR). When new records are detected in the file, the service will write the records out to the Pricer text file (ESL.001) and delete the Btrieve records.

### New Back Office Control File Settings

To support this new enhancement, the following 2 new Back Office Control File Settings are implemented in this release:

#### Enable Pricer Interface

One (1) character alpha field. This field requires **Y** for Yes or **N** for No. Setting this to “Yes” will activate the Pricer Server Service on this computer.

#### Pricer Export Day# (Sun=1)

One (1) digit numeric field (1 through 7). Enter the number associated with the day of the week to export the entire Item File to Pricer.

### Modified Back Office Control File Setting

The previous Back Office Control File Setting “Warn after # Min EJ Activity” has been renamed since it now also controls the time out setting for both the EJ Processor and Pricer Service.

#### # Min Process Inactivity Alert

Three (3) digit numeric field. Enter the number of minutes of EJ inactivity and/or Pricer Service inactivity that must pass before ScanMaster will issue a warning.

## VISA Compliancy

Customer Account Number, Expiration Date, PIN (Personal Identification Number) and KSN (Key Serial Number) data are now masked in the settlement file, log file and authorization file. In addition, all account numbers and expiration dates are masked or removed from printing receipts and signature slips. This applies to Debit, Credit and EBT tenders.

### Removed Register Control File Options

As part of this enhancement, the following Register Control File Options have been removed from the EFT tab:

#### **Mask Acct Num on Str Sig Slips [EFT]**

One (1) character alpha field. This field requires **Y** for Yes or **N** for No. If set to "Yes", the customer's card number (if configured to print) will be masked on the store's copy of the EFT Signature Slip.

#### **Disable Exp Date on Sig Slips [EFT]**

One (1) character alpha field. This field requires **Y** for Yes or **N** for No. If set to "Yes", the customer's card expiration date will not appear on the EFT Signature Slip.

## RPO for ScanMaster

Retailix Pocket Office (RPO) is available in ScanMaster Release 1.03.00. The following RPO modules are now supported from the iPad:

- Shelf Audit - provides the tools to audit shelf prices and make price changes
- Batch Item Maintenance – maintenance batches created using this module are downloaded to ScanMaster for activation
- Item Maintenance - turns the iPad into a powerful tool for facilitating ScanMaster Item Maintenance
- Dashboard - provides a tool to manage and monitor POS activity

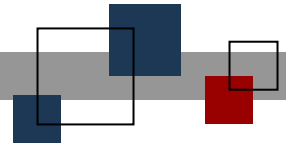

## S&H Interface Enhancements

Five new fields have been added to the item message sent to S&H Greenpoints for transactions involving item weight. The new fields will prevent computation inconsistencies involving point redemptions on weighted items. These fields are:

- Sign of Running Total – The sign (positive/negative) of the transaction total
- Running Total – The running dollar amount of the transaction
- Item Weight – The weight purchased (per the POS scale) including the fraction point of the weight unit
- Unit or Deal Quantity/Weight – The item quantity or weight that triggered the deal price including the fraction point of the weight unit
- Deal Price – The price charged per deal quantity or deal price
