ISS45 and Pricer — Backing Up Pricer ESL Files Before Upgrading ISS45 V7 or V8

Current V7 and V8 upgrades do not manage Pricer ESL files. As a result, some previously installed Pricer files (on MFS1 or MFS2) can be overwritten with non-ESL files during a V7 or V8 upgrade, which will make Pricer ESL software perform incorrectly.

If the box interfaces to Pricer ESL, you *must* back up the following files and directories before performing an upgrade on any ISS45 MFS1 (V7 or V8) software:

- C:\PCMASTER\PLU2ELDT.EXE
- C:\PCMASTER\PLU2ELDT.INI
- C:\PCMASTER\ELDATEOD.BAT
- C:\PCMASTER\SEQ\PLU2ELDT.PTR
- C:\PCMASTER\SEQ\PRICER (the entire directory)
- C:\PCMASTER\SEQ\MCOSM (the entire directory, if it exists)

Note: the directories listed above are being backed up as a precaution even though the upgrade does not touch them.

Once the upgrade has been completed, check that these files have not been replaced or modified. If necessary, copy the saved files back into the proper directories. Also, make sure you double-check the contents of the two directories copied before the upgrade.

Note: always back up your QDX files, the Q-DEX.PRM file, the TRANSVER.PRM file and any customized batch files before any upgrade.
