NOTE

The information in this bulletin was omitted from the ScanMaster 2.09.00-050 Release Notes regarding POS Enhanced Security.

ISSUE

When trying to enable POS Enhanced Security with ScanMaster 2.09.00-050 all of the options are grayed out.

RESOLUTION

Just as with BackOffice Enhanced Security, logged-in users can only select rights for settings that these users themselves are granted.

To initially set up the POS Enhanced Security the install/upgrade will install the new GR2PSECR.BTR file with only user 111 having all security flags enabled.

To initially set up POS security it will be necessary to have a user 111 in the employee file granted full rights. If a store has deleted this user, it will be necessary for a manager to at least build a temporary 111 user, then log on as 111 and grant all POS rights to a least one other manager account, which can then be used to set up the remaining POS security settings. Once this is complete, temporary user 111 can be deleted.
