ISS45 V7 and V8 C: Drive Partition Size

With the release of 7.0.9.0-050 (and above) and 8.0.8.0-050 (and above) the 4-gigabyte partition limitation for the C: drive has been removed for the MFS machines. C: drive partition sizes greater than 4 gigabytes have been tested and validated successfully.

This change is not yet reflected in the installation instructions contained on the release CDs. These documents will be revised in the subsequent document release.

Note 1: The 4-gigabyte partition limitation for drive C: has *not* been lifted for any releases below V7.0.9.0-050 and V8.0.8.0-050, nor for WinPoS terminal installations. The 4-gigabyte partition limit should continue to be implemented in these cases.

Note 2: This size restriction change for the C: drive does *not* remove the requirement to create a D: drive on all V8.0.8.0-50 (and above) systems.
