This is even better than the Demo kits we used to do! This is a “make-it-yourself” kit for whatever TeamPoS 2000 configuration you’d like to have for your Dealership’s demonstration setup.

Here’s how it works:

- Take a look at Marketing Bulletin #1157 and select **one** of the 45200/xxx packages. Want the Standard chassis? Fine. Want a 600MHz? Fine. Want a package with keyboards and displays or not? Whatever.
- Then add **one each** of any additional displays, keyboards, cash drawers, etc. you’d like to add to the kit, including options, cables, etc. These options must appear in the current issue of Marketing Bulletin #1157. Want one of each and every option in the bulletin? OK, if that’s the way you really feel about it.
- List the items you want on an order form.
- Add up the total list price and cut it in half. Remember this number.
- Add up the total list price again and apply a 50% discount. Compare this number with the other one you just calculated.
- If the two numbers match, **you’re a winner!** Get with John Bellamy and he’ll get your order out right away at whichever of the two identical prices you choose.
- But watch out — John’s just like Santa Claus. He’ll get you a present like this, but he’s “makin’ a list” and he’s “checkin’ it twice.” One order per Dealership Location per lifetime. That’s all, folks.
