



ISS45 User Documentation Packages

There are currently three installation configurations of ISS45 – Version 8, Version 7 with WinPoS and Version 7 with DOS. The User Reference Documentation for each of these three configurations is different.

Fujitsu is implementing a new system to minimize the duplication and shipment of unnecessary documentation. When a system is ordered, a no-charge PIN is added to specify which documentation set should be shipped with the system.

Put one of the following three PINs on “system” orders – that is, any orders that include the ISS45 Controller Service or ISS45 **Express**.

45209/DP7W	ISS45 Documentation Package – Version 7 WinPoS	N/C	N/A	N/A

For example, if an ISS45 **Express** system is purchased that will be installed as a Version 7 system using WinPoS, add 45209/DP7W to the order. If no documentation is put on the order, none will be shipped. Please note that these PINs are provided at no-charge at time of order, but Fujitsu cannot accept orders for these documentation packages and ship the manuals at no charge after-the-fact.

This method is being implemented immediately – it will ensure that the user gets the right documentation, while saving both the Dealer and Fujitsu money by eliminating wasted paper and shipping costs.
