



New Features — ISS45 7.7.1_55

Fujitsu is pleased to release ISS45 Version 7.7.1_55. This is a “Minor” release, designed for maintenance, but there are several new features also provided. This release is now available on the ISS45 Web Site at <http://www.iclretail.com/support/iss45/index.html>. Please see the Patch Table provided on the site for the list of fixes and enhancements, and the update itself.

The _55 release includes only WinPoS changes — there are no changes or enhancements to the DOS version in this release.

Besides the maintenance provided, new features include:

- **Enhanced Red Print option** — early in 2002, Fujitsu plans to ship new printers that support a Red Print option.¹ In earlier 7.7.1 releases, this option was soft-pedaled since it did not support the Reorganized Receipt at that point. As of 7.7.1_51, the Red Print option is supported including the Reorganized Receipt. A setup manual has been constructed, and is available on the ISS45 Dealer Web Site.
- **Enhanced Bad Accounts Checking** — ISS45 now checks the bad account file with the Frequent Shopper number even if a shopper is not paying by check. For stores that use the Frequent Shopper number as the check cashing number, the evil shopper will not be able to escape just because they’re not passing a bad check this time. Note that this option is not available in the Enhanced Bad Account option — just the Bad Account system.

¹ Note — printers with this support are currently available on the market, but testing to date has demonstrated that they don’t work right. Fujitsu is working with the printer vendors to improve the red printing to make them worthy of a general release and justify the cost of the two-color thermal paper.
