Fujitsu is pleased to announce that the Whammo! Program is being revived — at least in part.

Where the **ISS45** system can be enhanced via the various customization methods — including CustomLink and “hooks” we will once again entertain Whammo! Projects at \$995 or Double Whammys at \$1,995. We will do our best to minimize turnaround time, but feature and code complexity makes the original delivery times from the Whammo! Program impossible to fulfill in most circumstances.

GAS PUMP INTERFACE

The Gas Pump Interface, a piece of code that used Customlink to interface to Gilbarco PAM 1000 controllers, has been withdrawn. Originally released under Marketing Bulletin 1140, the interface is no longer available. This product did not have pay-at-pump capability, accounting in large part for the fact that there have were no known installations.

The good news is that Fuel Links, of Dallas, Texas, is readying what looks to be a great system that will integrate with **ISS45** — including pay-at-pump. We'll provide more information on this as we get closer to their release.
