### ScanMaster V1 PCI Sunset

June 1, 2010

PCI has declared that systems running on the DOS operating system are not eligible for PA-DSS, and a store running a DOS-based POS system cannot achieve PCI compliance. This is because DOS is no longer supported by its vendor, excluding it from any positive PCI status.<sup>1</sup>

In addition, there are no PIN pads interfacing with the ScanMaster V1 EPI (Electronic Payments Interface) that conform to the PCI-PED specifications, which required updated physical security and interlock mechanisms. To get around this requirement, it is frequently proposed that “grandfathered” units – used PIN pads originally installed in other stores – be installed. However, any such PIN pads were explicitly forbidden for re-install after January 1, 2008.

StoreNext therefore will not provide further PCI-related updates for ScanMaster V1, and ScanMaster V1 users are encouraged to upgrade to ScanMaster V2 as soon as possible.

<sup>1</sup> Note that ISS45 V7 is Windows-based (using a character-based box running over Windows, not DOS) and is therefore not affected by the no-DOS ruling at PCI.
