Yes, I know the numbering indicates a maintenance release, but there's all sorts of great stuff, like multiple Advanced Promotions against a single PLU, capability for Silver/Gold/Platinum, powerful new random-item LQD protections, Laser Printer setup support, and a bunch more. It even has a Release Notes User Reference you can get for free. See Marketing Bulletin 1129.
- **TeamCom:** These are the new TeamPoS configurations for that will run Windows programs. The 166 Pentiums also now come with 32 meg of RAM and no, we didn't raise the price. See the latest edition of Bulletin 1057 for all the details. (And yeah, there's so much in that bulletin now that it even has a Table of Contents so you can find your way around.)
- **266MHz** TeamPoS 5000 terminals. (Yes, that's 266.) Also in 1057.
