### Priceline.com Discontinues WebHouse Club

October 5, 2000

Priceline.com has notified members that its WebHouse Club program for groceries and gasoline will no longer be available. Other Priceline programs will continue unaffected.

Fujitsu-ICL and our **ISS45** Dealers have sold a number of interface licenses from **ISS45** to the Priceline WebHouse Club. This interface software is now of "limited value" to users.

While neither Fujitsu-ICL nor the RETAIL *partners* have no responsibility for WebHouse Club's demise, it still would leave your users stuck with a (small) software investment that they will be unable to recoup.

As such, Fujitsu-ICL will refund all paid licenses for the Priceline Interface (45180/071) to Dealers. This refund will take the form of a credit on your next **ISS45** system purchase. Our belief is that while this refund is not necessary, it is in keeping with a high-integrity business practice, and enables Dealers to take parallel actions with your users without a financial loss.
