NEW FEATURES AND CAPABILITIES

- **Item Hosting** – this is StoreNext’s Connected Services Hosting and Price Book package that replaces CIX and it’s now ready for the “soft launch.” Bring your customers now. An important regional chain liked it so much they’ve unplugged CIX and are using this product for all their ISS45 hosting needs. We’re looking for more StoreNext Dealers and users to take this system for hosting all their stores and files – please see the latest version of the [Connected Services Bulletin](#) that fully (and I *do* mean *fully*) describes what Item Hosting does for a chain.
- **Electronic Journal New Features** – now beyond what the EJ does in the store, the Connected Services EJ can now export to Excel, print an entire list without opening the receipts individually, multi-sort on different columns and within columns, and in general, given its database orientation, users can do faster and easier modifications of existing searches, filters and queries. Plus, everything you can do in the store including viewing Signature Capture.
- **Sales Analysis** – everything you could do with the Connected Services Reporting System, but now it works at *item level*. Lots of new features here for a low add-on price, so check out the latest version of the [Connected Services Bulletin](#) for the details.
- **Additional Data Storage** – by customer request, users can now get extra quarters of data storage for the Electronic Journal.
