## StoreNext adds Electronic Journal features to Connected Services offering

Connected Services EJ allows grocers to roam across all stores, including checkers that may work in multiple locations. Primary store or headquarters personnel can use it to check the frequency of voids, coupons and returns, creating a powerful security tool.
