StoreNext adds Grocery Dashboard to PocketOffice**New store management features display real-time graphical data from ISS45 system**

PLANO, Texas — Sept. 10, 2003 — StoreNext Retail Technologies LLC today announced a new wireless software application that enables grocery store managers and their associates to enhance customer service, increase efficiency of front-end store operations and reduce costs.

Grocery Dashboard instantly provides the status of the store's most important business and shopper service gauges on Fujitsu's lightweight iPad hand-held computer. Grocery Dashboard is supplied at no additional cost with StoreNext's PocketOffice, a suite of mobile applications giving independent grocers and small chains high-end mobile capabilities at a low-end cost.

Grocery Dashboard is being shown at the StoreNext booth #400A during Focus Advantage 2003, Sept. 10-13 at the Charlotte Convention Center in Charlotte, N.C. Focus Advantage is organized and sponsored by ICRDA/SDA, an industry association of dealers and resellers of point of sale (POS) systems. StoreNext is a joint venture of Fujitsu Transaction Solutions Inc. and Retailix Ltd.

With Grocery Dashboard, store managers get an instant graphical view of the entire store's front end, with each lane's number, status and personnel. Able to display the number of shoppers waiting at each lane, Grocery Dashboard helps store management monitor customer service levels and know exactly when to add or release checkers — from anywhere in the store. Optional cashier details include cashier name, number and the login timestamp indicating how long the clerk has been signed on. Managers can also send messages to all lanes or to specific cashiers that appear on the clerk's ISS45 POS display.

Grocery Dashboard also displays flash totals and total store sales for the day versus same-day sales for the previous week, references against average daily sales; total number of transactions and the average dollar amount per ticket. Cashier-specific figures include item, transaction, audit and productivity data.

“Grocery Dashboard gives store managers a real-time view of the front end from wherever they might be in the store,” said Tony van Seventer, head of marketing and products for StoreNext. “One quick look and they’ll know how the day’s business is going, plus be able to react instantly and open lanes when shopper service is degrading.

“The whole point of PocketOffice has been to give store people an inexpensive tool that makes management a pleasure — Grocery Dashboard takes this to a whole new level,” added Bruce Minale, StoreNext General Manager.

PocketOffice integrates with StoreNext’s ISS45 point-of-sale (POS) software and is sold as a complete package with Fujitsu’s iPad computer and fast, 11Mbit industry-standard 802.11b RF network components. Multiple applications operate locally on the iPad with Windows CE .NET to eliminate response delays, and data is transmitted wirelessly to the ISS45 system. Other PocketOffice applications – including Shelf Audit, Item Maintenance and Q-Buster™ - are provided with the purchase of PocketOffice. Current PocketOffice users may add Grocery Dashboard at no additional charge.

Fujitsu’s 11-ounce iPad is the lightest-weight handheld device available for retailers. It combines devices used throughout the store – scanner, magnetic- and smart-card reader, keypad with encryption capabilities, and voice over IP phone and video capability – to give the retailer a complete, wireless retail appliance. The Windows CE .NET-based iPad goes anywhere – to do virtually anything – including inventory management, debit transactions, price verifications, line busting, mobile POS, gift registry, loss prevention and more.
