



Marketing Bulletin - PADSS

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The PA-DSS (Payment Application Data Security Standard) is the Payment Card Industry Security Standards Council (PCI SSC) managed program formerly under the supervision of the Visa Inc. program known as the Payment Application Best Practices (PABP). The goal of PA-DSS is to help software vendors and others develop secure payment applications that do not store prohibited data, such as full magnetic stripe, CVV2 or PIN data, and ensure their payment applications support compliance with the PCI DSS.

Although Fujitsu has received a PA-DSS certificate of audit of the U-Scan® Version 4.3 software from an independent Payment Application Qualified Security Assessor, the PCI Security Standards Council (SSC) has ruled that U-Scan® 4.3 is **not a payment application** thus cannot be included in the PCI SSC listing of compliant applications as U-Scan® 4.3 does not meet the requirements for it to be considered a payment application.

Although U-Scan® is not subject to PA-DSS certification, Fujitsu has nonetheless undertaken and all of the steps necessary to **ensure that U-Scan® 4.3 be compliant in a PA-DSS regulated environment.** provided that clients follow the *U-Scan® PA-DSS Implementation Guide* which describes how the U-Scan® system and the environment that it should be run in order to be compliant with PA-DSS.
