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## **Sorbara's Shop n' Save Installs Self-checkout Units from StoreNext**

Independent Grocer enhances shopper service with belted and bagged self-checkout systems

Each installation includes two of the recently-released belted self-checkout units plus two five-bag U-Scan stations. All of these shopper stations are integrated with StoreNext's ScanMaster™ point-of-sale (POS) software at Sorbara's.

“Sorbara's Shop n' Save is among the growing number of leading independent grocers who realize that U-Scan's convenience, speed and choice equate to good customer service and enhances their shoppers' in-store experience,” said Ray Carlin, CEO of Plano, Texas-based StoreNext. “This trend has continued as more independents find that the returns from self-checkout have been well worth the investment.”

StoreNext dealer Retalix Pittsburgh worked in tandem with Sorbara's to install the self-checkout units and implement the combined U-Scan/ScanMaster systems. Retalix also will handle Sorbara's ongoing support and service.
