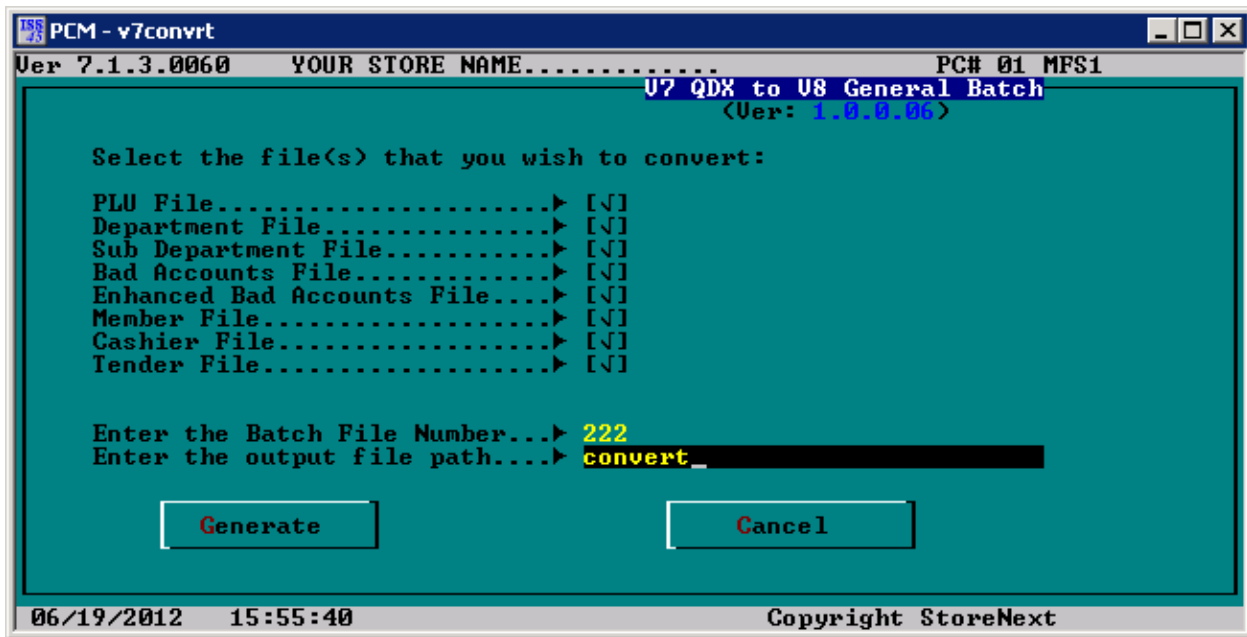


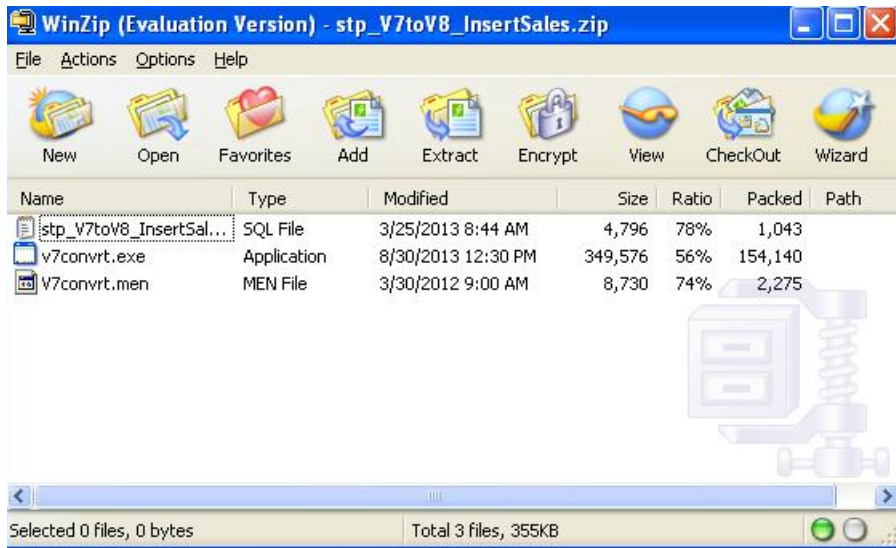
ISS45 V7 to V8 file Conversion

From the V7 system perform the following steps:

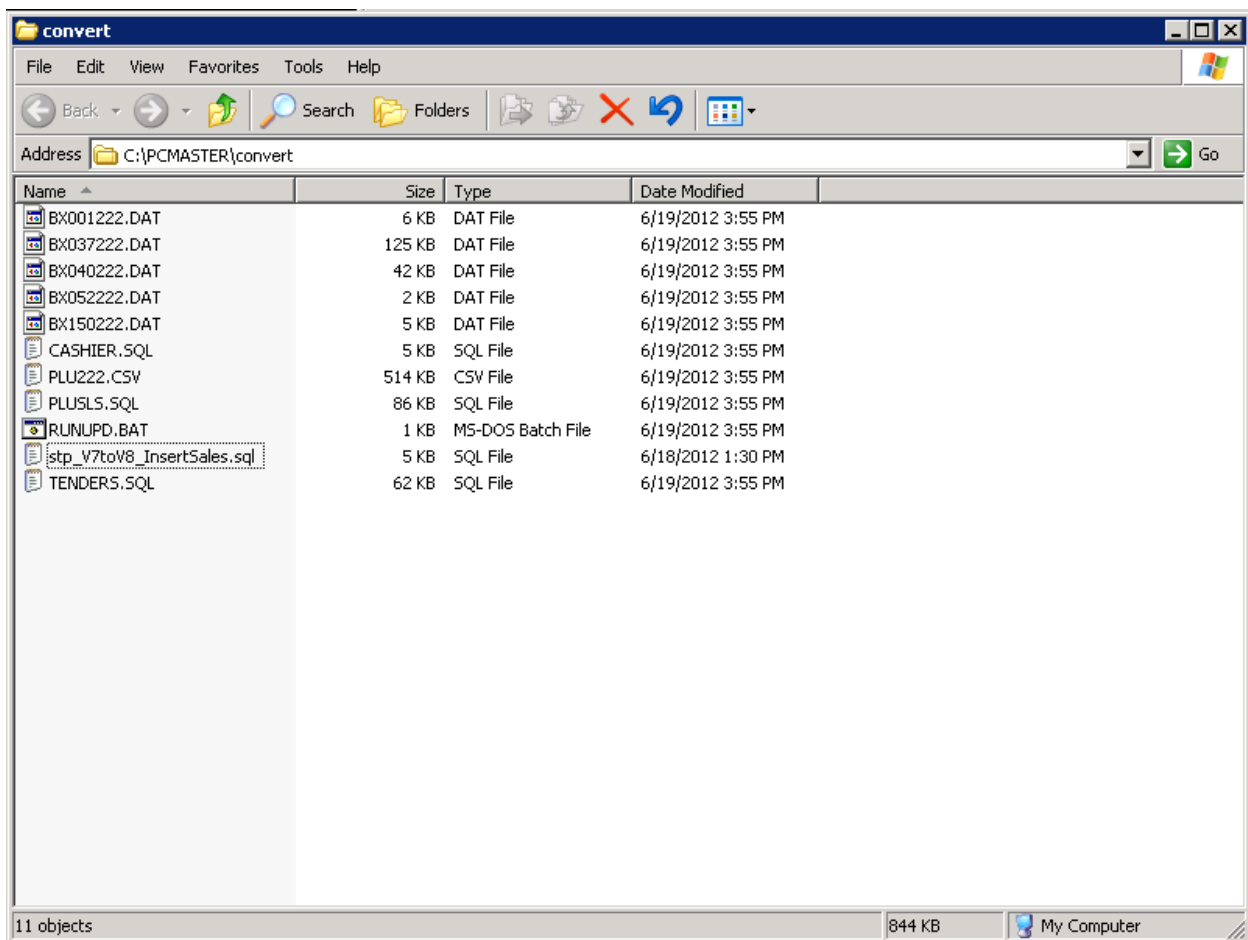
- Copy V7convrt.exe and v7convrt.men to \Pcmaster
- From PCMASTER menu select Exit to DOS (5)
- Run V7convrt.exe
- Select the files to create
- Define the Batch # you want created
- Create a folder in \pcmaster to write files to. Ex. convert
- Click on Generate



Copy stp_v7toV8_InsertSales.sql from the zip file as illustrated below to the file created above.



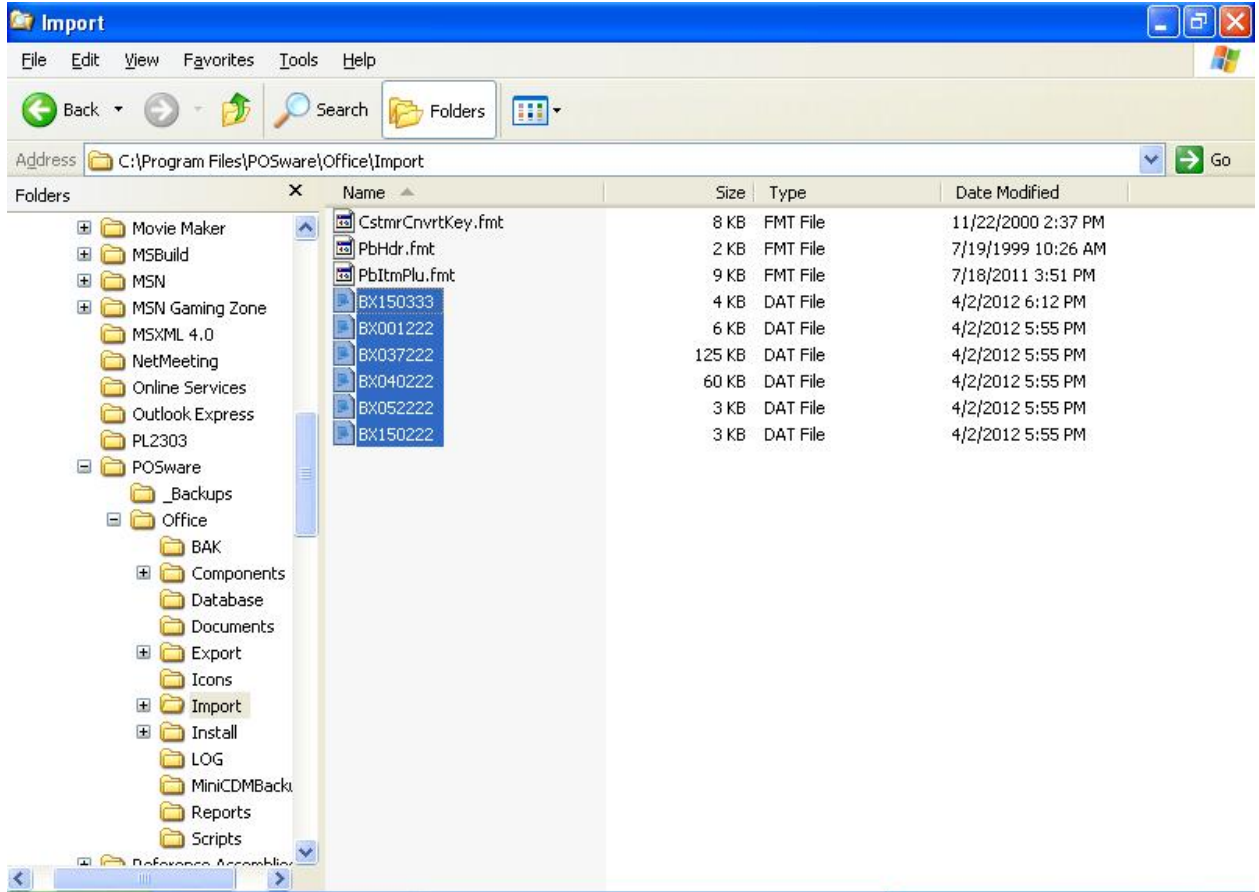
- The folder should look similar to this:



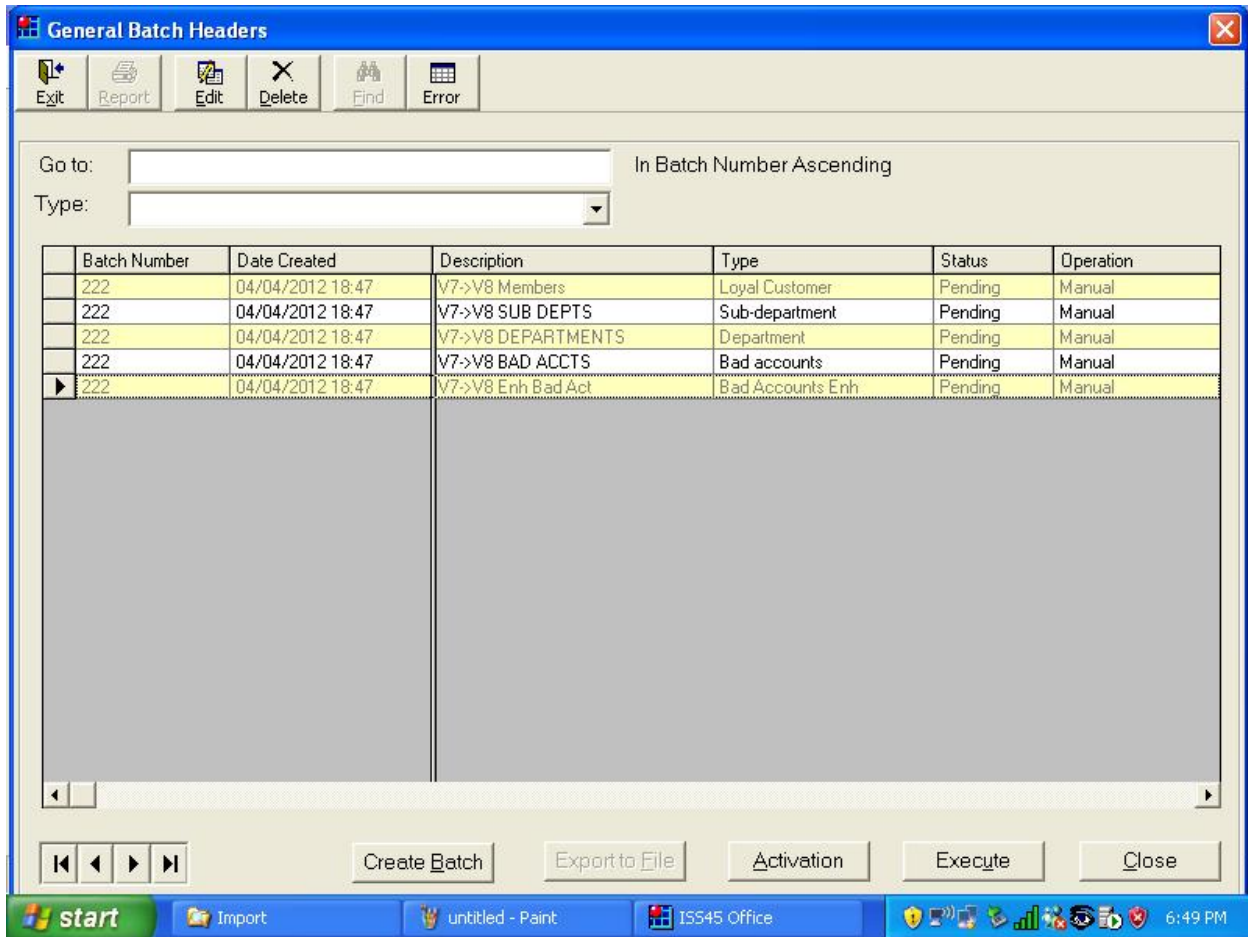
- When done copy the files created in the folder to a flash drive

From the V8 system perform the following steps.

- If the MFS1 has not performed an EOD since it was installed, do so now.
- Copy the BXXXXX.DAT files from the flash drive to the \program files\posware\office\import folder.

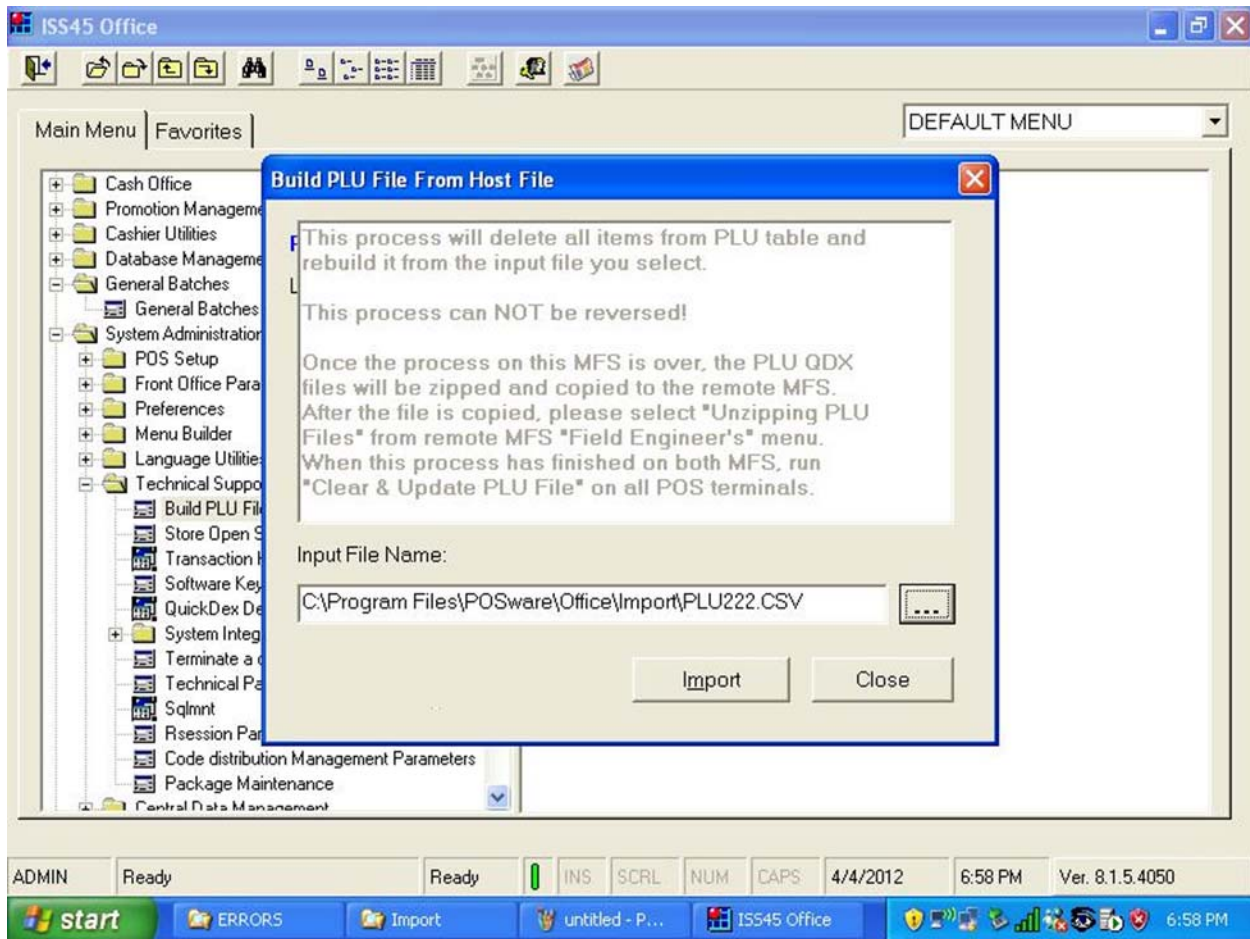


- These files will be converted to general batches
- Go to General batches to view files. The files will have the type of data being built i.e. V8 Members, V8 Sub Depts, V8 Departments, V8 Bad Accounts, V8 Enh Bad Act



- Execute the V8 Department General batch
- Execute the V8 Sub Department batch
- Execute the V8 Members
- Execute the V8 Bad accounts batch
- Execute the V8 Enhanced bad account batch
- Copy the PLUxxx(number you entered at the start of the conversion) from the flash drive to \program files\posware\office\import folder.
- Go to PLU Batches in the backoffice
- Execute the Full load batch
- Copy the stp_v7toV8_InsertSales.sql from the to the \program files\posware\office\scripts folder you just created.

- Go to System Administration\Technical support\Build PLU File from Host File
- At input File Name , browse to C:\Program Files\POSware\Office\Import\the file you named as the.csv file. It will have the same number you selected as the batch number at the convert selection:



- Copy runupd.bat to \programs\posware\office\scripts folder.
- Copy stp_v7toV8_InsertSales.sql, PLUSLS.sql, cashier.sql and tenders.sql to the \programs\posware\office\scripts folder.
- Execute runupd.bat from the \ programs\posware\office\scripts folder.
- Open a command prompt and change the directory to c:\pcmaster
- Type “q-empty 11” and press enter.
- Type “pcmceod /Casbldky” and press enter.
- Run an End of Day
- Open Cashier “Utilities/Reset Password” in FrontOff and reset the password for each cashier.
- Set the cashier passwords from the POS.

Notes: Once the process is completed it cannot be re-done with another conversion. The process will require an un-install of Version 8 and a re-load with an empty database.

Be sure you place all files in the proper folders as outlined in this document.

The plu.csv may process automatically run when the csv file is put into the import folder.
