# Introduction

A new feature was made recently to the ScanMaster system. These changes are reflected in the accompanying 2.09.00-070 software.

This enhancement is explained in detail in the following pages but is not included in your ScanMaster 2.09.00 User and Installation Guides.

## Long Descriptions on Customer Receipts

There is a mandate in the state of Illinois to ensure that every item printed on the customer receipt indicates the unit, size and measure (when applicable) of the item. Due to the previous 16-character (alphanumeric) size limitation of the description, ScanMaster was unable to print a comprehensible item description containing its unit, size and measure information. A new option in this release allows for the 30-character (alphanumeric) item description (a.k.a. Long Description) to be printed on the receipt.

In addition, in sites where two languages are used, the long description can include the item's description in a second language so that each item can have dual language representation on the receipt.

**Note:**

This feature is a receipt change only. It is the retailer's responsibility to maintain the long description in the store's item file. There are no changes to how items display on the cashier display, customer display and reports, or any front office functions which use the item's POS description.

**Note:**

The long description is maintained on the Labels Tab (in ScanMaster Item Maintenance) using the "Long Desc" field.

## New POS Workstation Setting

To add Long Description printing support, the following POS Workstation Settings are implemented in this release. (The tab where the setting is located within the ScanMaster System Configuration Editor is listed in brackets.)

### **Print Only Long Desc on Rcpt [Receipt]**

When set to "Yes" (and the option "Print Both Long and Short Desc" is set to "No") the long description of UPC-based items will print on the receipt on a line by itself above the extended price. If the long description is blank, the short POS description will print instead in the long description's location. In either case, the area to the left of the price (where the short description has historically printed) will be blank.

### **Print Both Long and Short Desc [Receipt]**

When set to “Yes”, the long description of UPC-based items will be printed on the receipt on a line by itself above the extended price. The short POS description will continue to print to the left of the extended price. If the long description is blank, its line will be skipped and the short POS description will print to the left of the extended price. If the option “Print Only Long Desc on Rcpt” is set to “Yes”, it will be ignored (since these two options are mutually exclusive).

# Technical Reference Appendix

## Windows 7 Issue Fixed

A problem with Cashier Monitoring (SM2CMON) locking up in sites running the Windows 7 Operating System has been resolved in this release.

## Patch Designation

When installing this patch, sites using the newer NCR POS Workstations (i.e. 7601 and 7606 models) should use the contents of the RegServPatchF or WinRegF folders (as would sites using Fujitsu and IBM POS Workstations). For older NCR Workstations, the contents of the RegServPatchN or WinRegN folders should be used.

## Out of Scope

Limitations of new features in this release are listed below (and were not addressed in development).
