ISS45 V7 End-Of-Day Batch Fix

With ISS45 V7 7.0.9.1_50 and later, during the end of day processing there is the possibility of a system hang from which the system cannot be recovered by rebooting MFS1. The reason for not being able to recover is the writing of a label at the beginning of the E-OF-DAY.BAT file that the system will not be able to find. This label is ASPHUK02.

The ASPHUK02 label is written to the E-OF-DAY.BAT file during the processing of the EODCLEAR.BAT file. In this instance it is not logical to have one batch file writing a label into another batch file.

To correct this situation a change must be made to the EODCLEAR.BAT file in any V7.0.9.1_50 or newer system. The line to be modified was added to the EODCLEAR.BAT file in July of 2004, so any system prior to 7.0.9.0_50 does not require this modification. V8 systems do not require this modification either.

Only one line in EODCLEAR.BAT must be changed by remarking out the erroneous line. Use Windows Notepad to add a remark statement (REM) to EODCLEAR.BAT on both MFS1 and MFS2 exactly as in the example below:
