ISS45 “Concord” Interface — Disable Cash Back

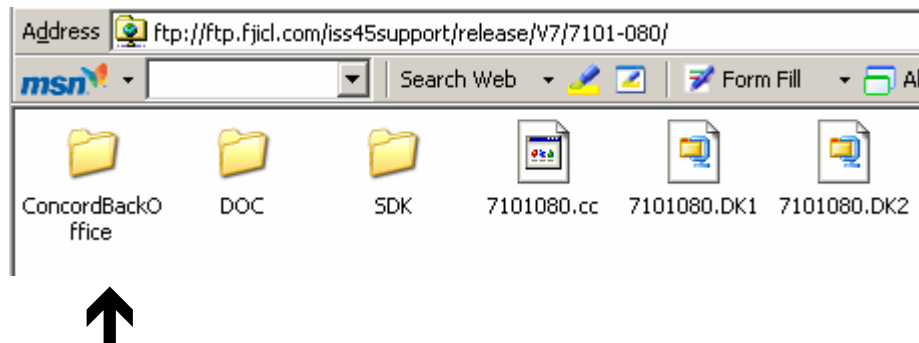

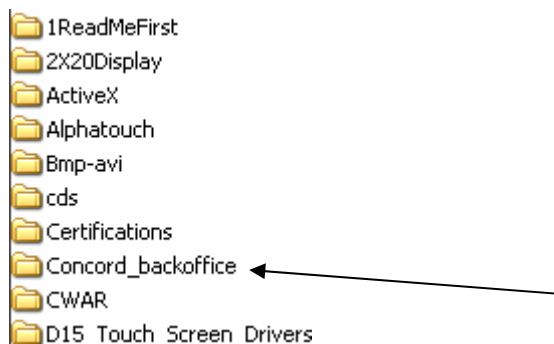
With the releases of 8.1.1.0-050 and 7.1.0.1-080 earlier this year, a feature was added that enables “Concord” (First Data Non-Stop Host) users to optionally disable the cash-back feature. When installing any release after 7.1.0.1-080 (e.g. 7.1.0.1-090 or 7.1.0.1-110), or after release 8.1.1.0-050 with a Concord EFT system, you should always install this new Concord version. It does not, however, itself have any effect on the release level for ISS45.

To use this feature you must install the new “Concord BackOffice.” This can be found either on the StoreNext Dealer Support Web site or the 8.1.1.0-050 CD-ROM.

- To take it from the Web site, call up the Release table for 7.1.0.1-080, click for the release and you will find it as shown below.



On the 8.1.1.0-050 CD, you will find the file CONCORD.DK1 in the following location and will be dated 12/16/2005 or later:
