HASP Key Requirements for ScanMaster 2.9.0-120 for Self-Checkout

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Note: This Issue 2a updates the ordering requirements for HASP key changes to enable these interfaces.

Changes to the HASP key system with the ScanMaster 2.9.0-120 release have been made that require the HASP keys to enable all self-checkout interfaces.

A reminder note has been provided on the 2.9.0-120 Release Table and the change is also discussed in the 2.9.0-120 Release Notes manual.

Unless the key is properly set, 2.9.0-120 will not support any self-checkout interfaces, including NCR SSCO or the U-Scan system.

Key updates are not required otherwise for the ScanMaster 2.9.0-120 release.

HASP updates will be provided with these functions upon receipt of a Purchase Order accompanied by a complete SKIF (see special SKIF requirements below).

- **Do not order the interface itself!** — If this type of key update is required, the customer has already purchased the necessary interface license. It just needs to be added to the HASP.
- **Instead** — Order the following item for each site/HASP to be updated:

- The order must be accompanied by a complete SKIF. To enable fulfillment of your order, make sure the SKIF includes:
 - The customer site name including the store number if applicable.
 - The Channel Partner's **original P.O. number** or NCR/Retalix/StoreNext **Sales Order number** under which the interface (the one that is now being added to the Software License Enablement Key) was originally purchased. Unless this information is provided, NCR will not be able to verify that the site is licensed for the requested interface, and the order will be declined.
 - The current ScanMaster HASP key number must be listed on the SKIF.
 - The SKIF must have all the site's existing key features checked in the "Already Has" column. Use the previous SKIF from your files or the POS system's Key Report to populate the SKIF correctly. Do not put the ProLogic or self-checkout interface features needed in this column, since the key does not "Already Have" them set.
 - Check the box in the "Adding Now" column for the self-checkout interface that the customer had previously purchased but is not currently on the HASP.

- If the interface product has been withdrawn for new sale (like the U-Scan Interface) and a check-box is not provided for the item on the SKIF, enter "Please Add" in the empty cell without the check-box.
- Follow the normal ordering process with NCR Order Entry. The HASP key set and store license will be matched against the store's original orders; the HASP key will be updated if the SKIF information enables confirmation that the site is licensed for the requested interfaces.
