

## ISS45 Quick Reference

### V7 Supervisor/Manager Scan Cards

February 3, 2010 Issue 2

Supervisor barcodes work off the privileges that are set in the Control Checks and the Cashier record.

The barcode **8888SSSSCCCC(K)** is unique for this function only.

The SSSS is the 4 digit store number. If the store number is 4, the number will have 88880004CCCC(K).

The CCCC is the 4 digit cashier number. This will be the cashier number of the manager or person that will have this card. If the number is 112, the barcode will now look like

888800040112(K). You must have a check digit on the end of the printed barcode.

If you do not have a utility or program to calculate the check digit, you can use the Coupon Printing Maintenance in ISS45. In the Barcode field type in 888800040112 and press ALT-K for check digit. The system will input the correct check digit.

This particular barcode can only be used at store #4. If this card was scanned at another store, you will see a message 'Incorrect Store Number'.

If you need a barcoded card that will work at all stores, use the 9999 in place of the store number.

You must set the Control Check as a Warning Only with a privilege of 1 to 8.

You must also have the cashier number that is on the barcode set to have the same privilege as the control check.

At the POS, the control check will display, you press the Clear key and it will ask for Supervisor Number and Password, at this point scan the card. One of two (2) actions will occur based upon system parameter #12 "Password Required with Cashier Bar-Doce", screen 6-1-2-1-3:

- 1) If this parameter is set to YES (on) a password MUST be entered
- 2) If this parameter is set to NO (off) NO password is required

You can also type in your number and password manually.
